ATTENDANCE POLICY

To benefit from their education, students should attend every day of the school year and attend every class every day on time.

- **Middle and High School students will not receive credits or a grade for any class upon the 11th absence from that class in a semester.**
- **Any exceptions, such as serious illness, can be made only if the student and his/her parents contact the school as soon as possible.**
- **Absences due to school sports or other school functions will not count toward this total of absences. It would be considered “SA,” Student Activity.**
- Report cards will not be issued prior to the last day of school for returning students. Final report cards will be posted on Skyward Family Access.
- We ask for at least two weeks advanced notice of planned absences. Make-up work and deadlines will be determined at teacher’s discretion. It is the student’s responsibility to inquire about missed assignments. Families should not plan to arrive late or leave early at the beginning or end of school or at holidays. Students who miss class time are responsible to complete all missed assignments and may cause themselves to earn no grade or lose a recommendation for promotion.
- Families must officially notify visregistrar@isgdh.org when they intend to withdraw.
